Notice from Tottori City

■Some of the methods for separating non-burnable garbage will change from April 1.

Hazardous garbage is added to the separation process.

Hazardous garbage has the risk of burning or exploding during garbage disposal, so it will be collected separately.

Hazardous garbage

lighters, spray cans, cassette canisters etc. rechargeable battery integrated product (mobile battery, wireless earphone, shaver, handy fan, rechargeable game console etc.)

How to dispose of hazardous garbage

Make sure to empty the lighter, spray cans, cassette canisters. No need to punch holes. Keep pressing until no gas comes out, and if there is any liquid remaining, soak it into paper or cloth. (Paper and cloth are combustible garbage.) Place it directly into collection container. If the product has a removable rechargeable battery, remove it, dispose of the rechargeable battery as a dry cell, and dispose of the product itself as non-burnable small garbage.

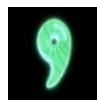

[Notes] When throwing out garbage, be sure to keep to the collection day and put it out by 8 a.m. However, garbage collection may be canceled due to natural disasters, etc. If you have difficulty taking out the garbage, please dispose of it on the next collection day (safe day).

Starting from April, “hazardous garbage” and “dry batteries etc.” will be collected once a month, with collection days determined by region. For information on how to dispose for garbage and collection dates, please check the “2024 Garbage Collection Plan” appendix in the March issue of the city newsletter.
