What We Do at the International Exchange Plaza

1 Room Rentals

The International Exchange Plaza has a variety of rooms of different sizes, including a multipurpose hall and a kitchen. They can be used free of charge for international exchange events and activities by groups of foreign residents.

3 Programs for International Understanding

- (1) We hold classes to learn foreign languages, cultures, and cuisines (for Japanese residents).
- (2) We offer classes where participants can experience Japanese culture, such as tea ceremony and kimono dressing (for foreign residents).

2 Support for Foreign Residents in the Community

- (1) We introduce Japanese volunteers who teach Japanese to those who want to learn the language.
- (2) We hold a "Nihongo Cafe", where people can enjoy casual conversation in Japanese.
- (3) We provide second-hand daily necessities to foreign residents.
- (4) We offer daily life consultation services for foreign residents (in English and Chinese).

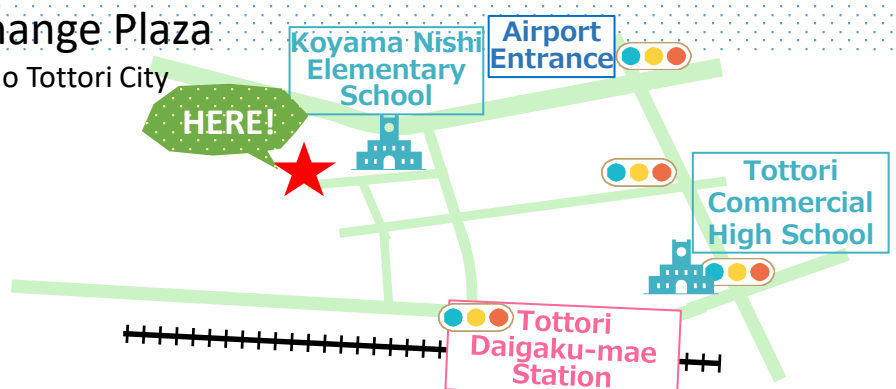
