

# **The vaccination is not compulsory. You will only be vaccinated if you wish to.**

## **1. Before getting vaccinated**

### **(1) For those with a primary care physician, and those with prior diseases:**

Those with underlying diseases and those taking medication might have to be careful about getting vaccinated. Please consult with your primary care physician before getting vaccinated.

### **(2) Choose either individual vaccination or mass vaccination at a vaccination site, and make an appointment:**

- ① Individual vaccination: If you wish to get vaccinated by your primary care physician or at the medical institution you usually visit, please consult with your primary care physician whether they can perform the vaccination.
- ② Mass vaccination: If for example you do not have a primary care physician, or do not wish to get an individual vaccination, you also have the option of getting vaccinated at a vaccination site in your area. Please make an appointment by phone call through the Tottori City Corona Vaccination Information Hotline below.

## **2. On the day of your vaccination**

### **(1) The vaccine will be injected around the area of your shoulder.**

**Please wear clothes that can easily expose your shoulder.**

### **(2) You cannot get vaccinated if you are sick.\***

**Let the doctor know if you are not feeling well during the medical examination!**

\* Examples of cases when you cannot get vaccinated:

- If you have a fever of over 37.5°C.
- If you have a severe acute disease.
- If in the past you have had allergic reactions to any of the components of the vaccine.  
etc.

### **(3) To get vaccinated you need to bring with you:**

- ① Your vaccination ticket
- ② A personal identification document (your passport, residence card etc.)
- ③ Your prevaccination screening questionnaire

If you have troubles with the appointment process or questions about the vaccination in general:
